

CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)

Federal law was revised effective June 12, 2022, discontinuing COVID-19 testing requirements for airline passengers travelling to the United States or its territories from foreign countries. There currently is no Federal Law requirement for wearing masks on the aircraft.

FEDERAL LAW REQUIREMENTS AND MANDATES REGARDING COVID-19 AND ITS VARIANTS HAVE BEEN MODIFIED SEVERAL TIMES SINCE ORIGINALLY ADOPTED AND MAY BE MODIFIED FURTHER FROM TIME TO TIME. SPECIFICALLY, THE CDC WILL REACCESS THIS DECISION LIFTING THE COVID-19 TESTING REQUIREMENT 90 DAYS AFTER ITS EFFECTIVE DATE. THEREFORE, IT IS IMPORTANT THAT EACH PASSENGER REVIEWS, PRIOR THE FLIGHT, THE FOLLOWING WEBSITES TO BE AWARE OF THE MOST CURRENT UPDATES OF THESE REQUIREMENTS AND MANDATES:

IN ADDITION, YOU ARE ADVISED THAT GOVERNMENTS OF CERTAIN COUNTRIES OR STATES, ON SHORT NOTICE, MAY IMPOSE COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS AND REQUIREMENTS ON ARRIVING PASSENGERS THAT MAY CAUSE INCONVENIENCE, QUARANTINES OR RESTRICTED ENTRY.
